Definitizing the Constitution

- Each State must definitively declare that the only Constitution they recognize is the organic Constitution.
- The Organic Constitution is the original Constitution that was ratified along with the 28 existing Amendments and that this is the only legitimate Constitution... not the <u>annotated Constitution</u> or any other derivative produced outside the authority of the States and outside the Article V process.
- The States also recognize that the terms and definitions provided by the Federalists during the Ratification Debates are the legally binding terms and definitions of the Constitution for the United States.
- The action of the Wyoming Legislature offers a pattern for what this should look like (HB-0132 2022):

Enforcing the Constitution as the Supreme Law of the Land

Definitize The Constitution and its 28 Amendments

- Upon establishing what is the definitive Constitution as the Supreme Law of the Land, the State needs the Legislature to do a thorough audit of the Constitution to ensure it defines the jurisdiction of the General Government; based upon the enumerated roles, responsibilities, and powers within the Constitution its ratified amendments and the processes
- Based upon the Ratification Debates and Madison's Notes on the Constitutional Convention, the States need to define:
 - o Enumerate ALL RRPs + that are delegated in the Constitution
 - Enumerate all Roles delegated
 - Enumerate all Responsibilities delegated
 - Enumerate all Powers delegated
 - Enumerate all Property delegated
 - Enumerate Judicial Jurisdiction
 - "arising under this Constitution, the Laws of the United States, and Treaties made, or which shall be made, under their Authority"
 - Enumerate all Criminal Jurisdiction delegated
 - What jurisdiction over crimes has been delegated to the general government to define and determine punishment within the Constitution
 - Define Treason based upon Whiskey Rebellion
 - Enumerate ALL Congressional Violations
 - Enumerate ALL Judicial Violations via rulings and opinions (the Judiciary possesses no legislative powers)

 Enumerate ALL Executive Violations via Executive Orders (the Executive possesses no legislative powers)

Petitions

 That the original Constitution for the United States and its 28 ratified amendments are the only recognized Constitution – that the general governments creation, use, and maintenance of an annotated Constitution is NOT an enumerated RPP; therefore, the States must use the Ratification Debates to assert the provided terms and definitions of the Constitution and ALL things defined and clarified are not open to debate or interpretation without an Amendment to the Constitution.
